***ALAIMUS HUNGARICUS* n. sp. AND *CLAVICAUDOIDES*
LONGICAUDATUS n. sp. TWO NEW SOIL-INHABITING NEMATODES
FROM HUNGARY**

Abstract

Alaimus hungaricus n. sp. and *Clavicaudoides longicaudatus* n. sp. are described and illustrated. *Alaimus hungaricus* is distinguished by its conoid – rounded lip region a long tail, ventrally arcuate in a semicircle. *Clavicaudoides longicaudatus* differs from the related species of the genus by its long cylindrical tail measuring about seven anal body widths.
