ALAIMUS HUNGARICUS n. sp. AND CLAVICAUDOIDES LONGICAUDATUS n. sp. TWO NEW SOIL-INHABITING NEMATODES FROM HUNGARY

Abstract

Alaimus hungaricus n. sp. and Clavicaudoides longicaudatus n. sp. are described and illustrated. Alaimus hungaricus is distinguished by its conoid – rounded lip region a long tail, ventrally arcuate in a semicircle. Clavicaudoides longicaudatus differs from the related species of the genus by its long cylindrical tail measuring about seven anal body widths.
