OBSERVATIONS ON FIVE KNOWN SPECIES OF SPIRAL NEMATODES FROM PAKISTAN

Abstract

During a recent survey of plant parasitic nematodes, the following five known species of spiral nematodes representing two genera were found for the first time in Paistan: *Rotylenchus dalhousiensis*Sultan & Jairajpuri, 1979; *R. himprus* (Sultan, 1980) Fortuner, 1987; *R. jagatpurensis* Sultan, 1985; *Helicotylenchus oscephalus* Andrson, 1979; and *H. willmottae* Siddiqi, 1972. Morphometric data, drawing and brief descriptions of these species are given as well as hosts and localities of occurrence in Pakistan.
