## DESCRIPTION OF DOLICHORHYNCHUS (DOLICHORHYNCHUS) MOTIAII N. SP. (NEMATODA: TYLENCHIDA) AND OBSERVATIONS ON BASIROLAIMUS DUBIUS (CHATURVEDI & KHERA, 1979) SIDDIQI 1986 FROM PAKISTAN

## Abstract

Dolichorhynchus (D.) motiaii n. sp. isolated from sil around the roots of tuberose (*Polianthes tuberosa*) and motia Arabic jasmine (*Jasminum sambac*) and *Basirolaimus dubius* (Chaturvedi & Khera, 1979) Siddiqi 1986 isolated from soil around the roots of periwinkle (*Catharanthus roseus*) and china-rose (*Hibiscus rosa-sinensis*) from Karachi, Pakistan are described and illustrated herein. *Dolichorhynchus* (D.) motiaii comes close to D. (D.) phaseoli, D.(D.) parvus, D.(D.)nigericus and D.(D.) prophasmis on the basis of offset lip region, 12 longitudinal ridges and notched bursa. *Basirolaimus dubius* is reported for the first time from Pakistan.
