

**DESCRIPTION OF *SOLIDIDENS SWATIENSIS* N.SP.
(DORYLAIMIDA: NYGOLAIMOIDEA) WITH
OBSERVATIONS ON FOUR KNOWN
SPECIES FROM PAKISTAN**

Abstract

A new species of *solididens* Heyns, 1968 is described and illustrated. *Solididens swatiensis* n.sp. has L = 1.1-1.6 mm; a = 34.5-44.6; c = 44.6-57.3; V = 49-53; tooth = 12-12.8 μ m and is closely related to *S. bisexualis* (Thorne, 1939) Thorne, 1974 and *S. capensis* (Heyns, 1968) Ahmed & Jairajpuri, 1982 but differs from both in having smaller and slender body, longer tooth, lower c value and more anteriorly situated vulva. *Discolaimus texanus*, *Ecumenicus monhystera*, *Labronema digitatum* and *Mesodorylaimus clavicaudatus* are newly recorded from Pakistan which are briefly described and illustrated.
