FOUR NEW GENERA AND FOUR NEW SPECIES OF MONONCHS (NEMATODA)

Abstract

Caputonchus capitatus n. gen., n. sp., *Mulveyellus* n. gen., *Nigronchus parus* n. gen., n. sp., *Truxonchus* n. gen., *Actus nanurus* n. sp. and *Crassibucca Colombia* n.sp. are described. *Truxonchus confundus* n. nom. is proposed as a replacement name for *Anatonchus paralleni* Jairajpuri & Khan, 1982 which is considered nomen nudum. *Mulveyellus antedontus* (Mulvey, 1963) n. comb., *M. antedontoides* (Coetze, 1967) n. comb., *M. jairi* (Lordello, 1959) n. comb. (type-species), *M. longicaudatus* (Baqri, Baqri & Jairajpuri, 1978) n. comb., *M. monhystera* (Cobb, 1971) n. comb. and *M. vorax* (Cobb, 1971) n. comb. are proposed for species previously under *Iotonchus* or *Mononchus*. *Truxonchus alleni* (Mulvey, 1961) n. comb. *T. dolichurus* (Ditlevsen, 1911) n. comb., *T. mulveyi* (Altherr, 1968) n. comb. and *T. subacutus* (Mulvey, 1961) n. comb. (type-species) are proposed for species previously under *Anatonchus*.
