DESCRIPTION OF CEPHALOBUS SACCHARI N. SP. AND REDESCRIPTION OF C. NANUSDE MAN, 1880 (NEMATODA: CEPHALOBIDAE) FROM PAKISTAN

Abstract

Cephalobus sacchari n. sp. collected from soil around the roots of sugarcane fields in Sindh, Pakistan, is described and illustrated. It comes close to Cephalobus persignis Bastian, 1865 but differs from it by having short body and stoma length; small V %; greater spicule length and long tail. C. nanus de Man, 1880; is reported for the first time from Pakistan.
