

RE-DESCRIPTION OF FOUR KNOWN CEPHALOBIDS (NEMATA: CEPHALOBIDAE) FROM PAKISTAN

Abstract

Four known species belonging to the family Cephalobidae (Rhabditida) viz., *Acrobeles complexus* Thorne, 1925; *Acrobeles mariannae* Andrassy, 1968; *Zeldia punctata* (Thorne, 1925) Thorne, 1937 and *Acrobelloides bodenhemeri* (Steiner, 1936) Thorne, 1937 have been reported for the first time from Pakistan. Brief descriptions and illustrations are given. The genus *Zeldia* Thorne, 1937 has been found as a new record from Pakistan.
