**TWO NEW AND TWO KNOWN SPECIES OF THE GENUS
MALENCHUS ANDRASSY, 1968 (NEMATODA: TYLENCHIDAE)
FROM PAKISTAN**

Abstract

Malenchus labiatus n. sp. and *M. pyri* n. sp. are described from Pakistan. *M. labiatus* n. sp. is distinguished from all the other known species of *Malenchus* in having a small disc-like structure on its lip region and vulval flaps. *M. pyri* n. sp. is closely related to *M. andrassyi* Merny, 1970 and *M. exiguus* (Massey, 1969) Andrassy, 1980 but differs from both in the absence of valvular plates in the median bulb. *M. andrassyi* and *M. nanellus* Siddiqi, 1979 are reported for the first time from Pakistan.
