## GRACILPAURUS CORBETTI GEN. N., SP. N. (NEMATODA: TYLENCHIDA: PARATYLENCHIDAE) FROM INDIA WITH A KEY TO THE SPECIES OF THIS GENUS

## **Abstract**

Gracilpaurus corbetti gen. n., sp. n. is described and illustrated. The new genus differs from Gracilacus Raski, 1962 by haging cuticular tubercles on swollen females, and quite often the empty cuticular sacs of its adult females encountered in soil. lt can also be differentiated are from Cacopaurus Thome, 1943 by having shorter stylet and longer post-vulval region. Three species of Gracilacus viz., G. crenatus, G. colina and G. mutabilis are transferred to Gracilpaurus. Gracilacus punctata Huang & Raski, 1986 is proposed junior synonym of *Gracilpaurus mutabilis* n. comb.
