**TWO NEW SPECIES OF THE GENUS *TYLENCHORHYNCHUS*
COBB, 1913 (NEMATODA: TYLENCHORHYNCHINAE)
FROM INDIA**

Abstract

Two new species of the genus *Tylenchorhynchus* Cobb, 1913 from India are described and illustrated. *T. clavus* n. sp. differs from closely related species viz., *T. crassicaudatus* Williams, 1960; *T. clavicauda* Seinhorst, 1968; *T. tarjani* Andrassy, 1969; *T. neoclavicaudatus* Mathur, Sanwal & Lal, 1979 and *T. levitermalis* Siddiqi, Mukerji & Dasgupta, 1982, in relative body length, spear length, shape of basal knobs and certain other characters. *T. projectus* n. sp. comes close to *T. ewingi* Hopper, 1959; *T. mashhoodi* Siddiqi & Basir, 1959; *T. silvaticus* Ferris, 1963; *T. zae* Sethi & Swarup, 1968 and *T. chirchikensis* Mavlianov, 1978 but differs in shape of spear knobs, relative tail length and number of tail annules among other characters.
