**DESCRIPTION OF *TYLENCHORHYNCHUS TUBEROSUS*
N.SP., AND OBSERVATIONS ON *DOLICHORHYNCHUS*
PHASEOLI (NEMATODA: DOLICHODORIDAE) FROM
ORNAMENTAL PLANTS OF KARACHI, PAKISTAN**

Abstract

Tylenchorhynchus tuberosus n. sp., collected from soil around the roots of tuberose (*Polianthes tuberosa* L.) can be separated from all the species of the genus on the basis of smooth continuous head, unstriated tail terminus. *Dolichorhynchus phaseoli* was for the first time found around the roots of various ornamental plants in Pakistan. Morphometric data and illustrations of *D. phaseoli* are given herein.
